Bonnie,

Their current mitigation proposal is conceptually acceptable.

It looks like they are proposing to fill approximately 2.3 to 2.4 acres of waters. Their mitigation proposal looks like about 3.4 to 3.5 acres of wetland and open water establishment. The devil is going to be in the details, but if they can give me detailed plans that give me some degree of comfort that those 3.4 acres of establishment will work, I should be able to put that on public notice and see how it goes. I'm not counting any of the "enhancement" in the 3.4-acre calculation.

This guarantees nothing as far as whether they ultimately get a permit. Based upon my experience though, it has a reasonable chance of getting a permit. We still have to run the process to see what happens.


